The Paneuropean Union – at its International Board meeting in Zagreb on 22 October 2022 has decided upon the following points on the Russian War of destruction against Ukraine:

- 1) Shocked by the overall breach of civil and human rights through the Russian attackers,
- 2) Desperate about the direct attacks against civilian aims and especially children,
- 3) As well as about the destruction of important infra structure like electricity, hospitals, and schools,
  - a) Urges the European Union (EU) to undertake more, new and noticeable boycott measures against the Putin regime.
  - b) Asks the EU to swiftly organise the military and humanitarian aid to Ukraine which Kiev is asking for.
  - c) Asks the EU, to clearly define the aim of the war: The final definition must be, to regain the territorial integrity of Ukraine.
  - d) Requires the quick creation of the legal prerogatives so that Russian frozen assets in the West can be used for the reconstruction of Ukraine.
  - e) Demands reparation payments from Russia to be able to repair all damage suffered in Ukraine by the war, and also demands reparation payments for all refugees, and the standard payments being based on the monthly sums being paid to Russian soldiers.
  - f) Pleads to support the forces in Russia that fight for a development of the Rule of Law in the country.
  - g) After a regime-change in Moscow, the Pan-European Union will work for the reintegration of a reformed Russia into the international society of states.
  - h) This resolution should be sent to all member organisations by the Secretary General asking them to forward it to the different governments and International Organisations in the countries concerned and also to distribute it to the media, to show Paneuropa's line of thought.

The President is asked to forward the resolution to all EU institutions.
